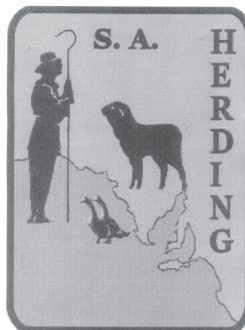

Instinct Tests

To be eligible to enter Herding Tests or Trials all dogs must be registered with Dogs SA and owners and handlers must be financial members of Dogs SA or an Interstate Controlling Body and must pass at least one Herding Instinct Test.

A list of eligible working breeds and the Rules for Herding Instinct Tests are on the ANKC Website at www.ankc.org.au

The Dogs SA Herding Advisory Committee is scheduling Instinct Tests on both sheep and ducks at SACA Park on Sunday 26th September 2010.

The Tests will commence at 1.30 pm with sheep before ducks. Vetting will be from 1.00 to 1.15 pm and all handlers must pass the check in by this time. There is a limit of 30 entries to be accepted and a ballot may be conducted if excess entries received.

The entry fee is \$15.00 which includes a \$5.00 stock levy. Entries on a standard form posted to:
